



Yarra Valley Grammar (**the School**), in accordance with Section 19 of ESOS Act and Standard 9 of the National Code of Practice for Providers of Education and Training to Overseas Students 2018 (National Code), implements the following policies:

- (a) unable to attend class;
- (b)

ii. being the victim of a serious crime, and this has impacted the overseas student

- (c) has medical concerns, severe depression or psychological issues which lead the provider to fear for the student's wellbeing;
- (d) has engaged or threatened to engage in behaviour that is reasonably believed to endanger the overseas student or others; or
- (e) is at risk of committing a criminal offence.

The School will keep evidence to support this finding.

In circumstances where the deferment or temporary suspension is approved by the School, a course variation will be recorded on PRISMS as appropriate or necessary. Students who have been suspended for more than 28 days may need to contact Department of Immigration. The period of suspension will not be included in attendance calculation.

School initiated cancellation of studies

The School may suspend or cancel the enrolment of a student under the following situations:

- (a) Misbehaviour by the student;
- (b) Failure to pay an amount that was required to be paid to the School to undertake or continue to undertake the course as stated in the Enrolment Agreement;
- (c) Serious breach of the provisions of the Confirmation of Approved Accommodation and

Deferment and c
